

V Gadget Competition

(2015 edition, translated from Spanish original)

Theme: Long Live San Andrés

PRIZES: €40/€25/€15 IN SCHOOL MATERIALS

Rules and regulations in relation to the Cacharro/Gadget competition, 2015, designed for the students in infant and primary public schools in Adeje during the 2015/2016 academic year.

OBJECTIVE

These rules are designed to regulate the V Gadget Competition in public infant and primary education centres in the borough of Adeje during the academic year 2015/2016.

In celebration of the feast day of San Andrés we would like to continue with the project we have followed in recent years. The celebration of this festival allows us focus on a number of interesting areas, as well as marking the start of the season of autumn. We also use it as an opportunity to promote recycling and creativity by encouraging people to take part in the competition to create a model made of recycled materials and subsequently display their work in a public exhibition.

Children from the Adeje primary schools, and their families, can participate with their artistic creations made from recyclable materials – cans, tins, boxes – and prizes will be awarded for originality and creativity. The theme this year is the fiesta of San Andrés, directly associated with the custom of 'cacharros'...so is under the 'Vive San Andrés' title.

PRIZES

This year (2015) the sum total of prizes to be awarded will be FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTY EURO (€480), divided in the following manner:

NUMBER AND WORTH OF PRIZES

There will be a first, second and third prize for each school/education centre. There will also be three certificates for runners up and all of those winners will also participate in the exhibition.

First prize: €40 voucher for school books and materials

Second prize €25 voucher for school books and materials

Third prize €15 voucher for school books and materials

WHO CAN ENTER

Any student who presents a work made from recycled materials, ideally using a can or tin as the primary material, but also using other materials as long as they are recycled, who is a student at a public Infants or Primary school in Adeje. Families of students are permitted to help them in the making of their creation, as long as they abide by the principals of the composition of the entry.

CANDIDATE SELECTION FROM EACH CENTRE

The directorate of each of the participating schools will chose the candidates for the main prizes. The winners and runners up will be chosen by an external jury in conjunction with the Adeje department of Creative Development, Sports and Learning. The jury will take into account the following criteria:

- Reflection of theme Vive San Andres
- Artistic creativity
- Family participation
- Originality
- Technical complexity of the work
- The percentage of recycled materials used in the work

The entries from each school will be presented within the schools and collected and brought for final judging by the teachers nominated for the purpose.

Each centre can submit 12 works for judging and the jury will pick three winners with three more from each school also taking part in the final exhibition. The creators of the works that don't receive a prize will receive a certificate.

The jury will be chosen by the department of Creative Development, Sports and Learning and will consist of the Adeje Councillor for Creative Development, Sports and Learning or his delegate, two jurors nominated by the department and two jurors nominated by each school.

The winners will be notified as soon as is opportune once the jury has reached a decision and the names subsequently will be published by the Adeje council in its publications online.

By entering a work for consideration the entrant and his/her family are, by implication, accepting the rules of the competition.



1. Each entry must be accompanied by a card IN A CLOSED ENVELOPE containing the following details:

The name of the work

The name of the student

Course

Age

Contact telephone number

2. The entry should have a sticker which has the name of the work and the same title should appear on the outside of the envelope. This is the only way in which the jury members will identify the work in question.

SUBMISSION DATES

The dates for presentation of entries is from November 16th to November 26th

PRIZE GIVING

There will be a prize giving event to which students and their families will be invited and at which the prizes and certificates will be awarded.

This event will be held in conjunction with the Adeje press office and photographs and information regarding the prize winners will be sent to local media.
